Final Report on Washington D.C. Learning Journey

As part of the grant agreement, all travel participants are required to provide a final report about their experience. Participants and groups are encouraged to show their personality and creativity in their final reports. Written, digital, artistic and video presentations are all acceptable formats as long as the criteria below are addressed:

- What youth learned on this excursion to our nation's capital, including their academic areas of interest and about themselves through the opportunity of travel.
- We want to understand how the trip connected them to academics or other programmatic education and skill development. Be sure to describe any pre-work done before the trip and any curriculum utilized during the trip. For example, how did you incorporate the Herb Kohl informational sheet to the visit? Or what did the students learn about civic engagement, will the learning opportunities continue post-trip?
- Tell us about your college visit.
- If your trip had any special customization or theme, please include feedback about that experience.
- We want to know how participants felt about the overall trip logistics and itinerary. Please let us know what sparked joy (or didn't!).

Please be sure to clearly identify the sponsoring school or organization and include the dates of travel. This information is used to measure satisfaction, improve the process and enhance the future learning journey experience.
